courts.

SEC. 7. *And be it further enacted*, That any and every court into which monies may be paid or deposited by agreement of parties, order, judgment or decree of such court, may order and direct the same to be deposited with said company; and any individual or administrator, guardian or committee, receiver, assignee, trustee, State, county or municipal government or corporation or public officer, or any person or persons acting for others, having the custody of any bonds, stocks, securities, monies or valuables, shall be authorized to deposit the same for safe keeping with the said company.

May secure
payment of
notes, etc.

SEC. 8. *And be it further enacted*, That said company shall have power to guarantee, endorse and secure payment and punctual performance and collection of notes, debts, bills of exchange, contracts, bonds, accounts, claims, rents, annuities; mortgages, choses in action, evidences of debts, certificates of property of value, checks and titles to property, indebtedness of individuals, of companies, partnerships, contracts, loans of States, cities, counties and municipalities, on such terms or commissions as may be agreed upon or established by said company and the parties dealing therewith.

May receive
upon stor-
age plate,
etc.

SEC. 9. *And be it enacted*, That said company may receive upon storage, deposit or otherwise, merchandise, specie, plate, bullion, stock, promissory notes, certificates and evidences of debts, contracts and all other personal property, and advance money thereupon on such terms as may be established or approved by said company; that in all cases in which public officers or municipal or private corporations are authorized to deposit money, stocks, bonds or evidences of debt, such deposits by said officers or corporations may be made with said company.

May execute
trusts of
every des-
cription.

SEC. 10. *And be it enacted*, That said company may and it is hereby authorized to accept and execute trusts of any and every description which may be committed or transferred with their consent to them by any person or persons whomsoever, bodies corporate or public, or by any court in the State of Maryland or in any one of the United States; and to accept the office and appointment of executors and administrators of any kind or nature, whenever such office or appointment is conferred or made by any person or persons or by any Orphans' Court or other court, either in this State or in any one of the United States; and that in all cases in which application shall be made to any court of this State for the appointment of any receiver, trustee or administrator, executor, assignee, guar-
