## CHAPTER 369.

AN ACT making appropriations for the support of the State Government for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of September, 1897.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Marytions for land, That for the expenditures in the support of the State ending with the first day of sept. 30, 1897. October, 1896, and ending with the thirtieth day of September, 1897, the following sums of money or so much thereof as may be necessary, be, and the same are hereby appropriated—that is to sav:

For the salary of the Governor, four thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the Secretary of State, two thousand dollars; for the salary of the messenger to the Governor, one thousand dollars; for the salary of the Comptroller of the Treasury, two thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the chief clerk to the Comptroller, eighteen hundred dollars; for the salary of two assistant clerks to the Comptroller, fifteen hundred dollars each, three thousand dollars; for the salary of two assistant clerks to the Comptroller, twelve hundred dollars each, twenty-four hundred dollars; for the salary of the Treasurer of the State, two thousand five hundred dollars; for the salary of the chief clerk to the Treasurer, eighteen hundred dollars; for the salary of two assistant clerks to the Treasurer, each twelve hundred dollars, twenty four hundred dollars; for the salary of one clerk to the State Tax Commissioner, twelve hundred dollars; for the salary of State Librarian, fifteen hundred dollars; for the salary of the Commissioner of the Land Office, fifteen hundred dollars; for the salary of one clerk to the Commissioner of the Land Office, twelve hundred dollars.
