CHAPTER 455.

AN ACT to refund to the Arundel Building Company of Baltimore city, a certain sum of money erroneously paid into the State Treasury.

Appropriation.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Comptroller of the Treasury, be and he is hereby authorized and directed to draw his warrant upon the treasurer, in favor of the Arundel Building Company of Baltimore city, for the sum of thirty-seven dollars and fifty cents, being the amount erroneously paid into the State Treasury, as a bonus tax upon the increase of the capital stock of said company.

CHAPTER 456.

AN ACT to appropriate certain sums of money to the support of sundry schools and charitable institutions in the State of Maryland, for each of the two fiscal years ending on the thirtieth day of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, and on the thirtieth day of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, respectively.

Appropriations to schools and charitable institutions.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sums of money hereinafter named, be and they are hereby appropriated to the support of the hereinafter mentioned schools and charitable institutions in the State, for each of the two fiscal years ending on the thirtieth day of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, and on the thirtieth day of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-eight, respectively, to wit:
