like sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight.

- 41. To the St. Elizabeth's Home of Baltimore city for Colored Children, the sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, and the like sum of one thousand dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight.
- 42. To the Oblate Sisters of Providence the sum of five hundred dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-seven, and the like sum of five hundred dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight.
- 43. To the Home for Confederate Mothers and Children, the sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety seven, and the like sum of three thousand dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-eight.
- 44. To St. John's College, Annapolis, for the purposes of said institution, the sum of five thousand dollars for the fiscal year of eighteen hundred and ninety-seven.

Payment of appropriations.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the Treasurer of the State shall, upon the warrant of the Comptroller of the Treasury, pay the said sum of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes hereinbefore specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons or bodies corporate entitled to receive the same.

AN ACT to incorporate the Equitable Fire Insurance Company of Snow Hill, Maryland.

A body corporate.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That George S. Payne, Robley D. Jones, George W. Purnell, Edward White, Oscar M. Purnell, J. Edward White, William F. Johnson, and Francis Henry Purnell, of Snow Hill, Maryland; Calvin B. Taylor and Zadok P. Henry, of Berlin, Maryland; Zadok P. Wharton, of Stockton, Maryland; and Edgar W. McMaster, of Pocomoke City, Maryland, and whosoever may be now or hereafter associated with them, and their successors, shall be and are hereby made a body politic and corporate by the name and style of the Equitable
