An Act to authorize and empower the "Burgess and Commissioners of Williamsport" of Washington County, Maryland, to borrow money on the credit of the said town for the purpose of supplementing, enlarging, increasing and adding to the Electric Light Plant and System now belonging to and operated by the said town, as provided for by Chapter 27 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland passed at its January Session, A. D. 1898, and to issue bonds for the payment of the same, and to levy on the assessable property of the said town to redeem said bonds and to pay the interest on the same.	25
