

CHAP 192. Meeting shall be held. church shall be held, notice of which shall be given as afore-said, at which the acceptance or rejection of the amendments to the article of incorporation of said church contained in this Act shall be determined, and if determined in the affirmation, then the amendments contained in this Act shall immediately become operative, and said determination shall be entered upon the minutes of said meeting.

Who shall compose board of trustees. SEC. 7. *And be it enacted*, That the members of the board of trustees of said church for the first year, that is to say, from the acceptance of this Act until the regular annual nomination and election to be held in January and February next shall be Walter E. Burns, William A. Crawford, J. Swan Everist, James W. Foster, Andrew C. Jackson, Stephen J. Seneca, Robert K. Vanneman, Charles T. Wilson and Augustus C. Crothers, three of whom shall serve until the said nomination and election, three until the nomination and election in January and February, 1904, and three until the nomination and election in 1905, and they shall determine by lot at their first meeting after the acceptance of this Act, the respective terms of each, and the result of said determination shall forthwith be entered upon their minutes.

SEC. 8. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 193.

AN ACT to empower the County Commissioners of Frederick County to give to Railway Companies the right to use county roads.

Right and power to build granted. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Frederick county are hereby authorized and empowered to grant to electric railway companies the right and power to build their lines of railway on and across public roads, subject to the consent of the said County Commissioners of Frederick county.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 194.

AN ACT to repeal Section 17 B of Article 77 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Public Education," sub-title "Superintendent of Public Education," and re-enact the same with amendments.
