

ject to revision and correction by said County Commissioners, and nothing in this section shall be construed to interfere with or affect the rights, powers and duties of the County Commissioners under and by virtue of the general laws of the State in relation to such new or other assessment of property, and for making return of property to the County Commissioners under this section the Treasurer shall receive as compensation for such services the sum of \$250 per annum.

### CHAPTER 345.

AN ACT making appropriations for the support of the State Government for the fiscal year ending on the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred and three.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That for the expenditures in the support of the State Government for the fiscal year beginning with the first day of October, nineteen hundred and two, and ending with the thirtieth day of September, nineteen hundred and three, the following sums of money, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same are hereby appropriated, that is to say :

#### FOR STATE OFFICERS.

For the salary of the Governor, four thousand five hundred dollars ; for the salary of the Secretary of State, two thousand dollars ; for the salary of the Messenger to the Governor, one thousand dollars ; for the salary of the Comptroller of the Treasury, two thousand five hundred dollars ; for the salary of the Chief Clerk to the Comptroller, eighteen hundred dollars ; for the salary of three Assistant Clerks to the Comptroller, fifteen hundred dollars each, four thousand five hundred dollars ; for the salary of one Assistant Clerk to the Comptroller, twelve hundred dollars ; for the salary of the Treasurer of the State, two thousand five hundred dollars ; for the salary of the Chief Clerk to the Treasurer, eighteen hundred dollars ; for the salary of one Assistant Clerk to the Treasurer, fifteen hundred dollars ; for the salary of one Assistant Clerk to the Treasurer, twelve hundred dollars ; for the salary of one Clerk to the State Tax Commissioner, fifteen hundred dollars ; for the salary of one Clerk to the State Tax Commissioner, twelve hundred dollars ; for the salary of the State Librarian, fifteen hundred dollars ; for the salary of the Commissioner of the Land Office, fifteen hundred dollars.
