CHAP. 351. four, entitled 'City of Baltimore,' of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland," and the several Acts and parts of Acts amendatory thereof, and to re-enact said Article four with amendments, under two sub-titles, to be known as "Charter and Miscellaneous Laws," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:

Ferry boats to be run.

435. The said corporation shall keep and run on their ferry routes two good and substantial steam ferry boats, staunch and seaworthy, and supplied according to the law in such cases made and provided; and the said corporation shall so manage the said ferry as that one of their ferry boats shall leave each end of said ferry at least every ten minutes between the hours of six o'clock A. M. and eight o'clock P. M., and at intervals of twenty-five minutes between the hours of eight o'clock P.M. and twelve o'clock midnight; provided, that the requirements of this section shall be directory only and not mandatory upon said corporation when the weather, public convenience or traffic justify said corporation in altering said requirements.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 352.

AN ACT to add additional Sections to Article 23 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Wicomico County," subtitle "Salisbury," to be designated as Sections 1 A. 1 B. 146 A and 146 B.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the following sections, to be designated as sec-New sections tions 1 A, 1 B, 146 A and 146 B, be and the same are hereby added. added to the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Wicomico County," sub-title "Salisbury," and to follow sections 1 and 146, respectively.

1 A. All property and franchises of every kind belonging to or in possession of the Mayor and Council of Salisbury are tranchises vested in said corporation. The said corporation may receive vested in said in trust and may control for the purpose of said trust, all vested in said corporation. The said corporation may receive moneys and assets which may have been or shall be bestowed upon it by will, deed or any other form of gift or conveyance in trust for any general corporate purpose or in aid of the indigent poor or for any general purpose of education, or for charitable purpose of any description within the said city.
