

CHAP 43. copies or extracts of any papers in the office of the County Commissioners, of which copies or extracts may by law be required or by their permission granted, and shall be entitled to the same fees for such services as the clerk of the Circuit Court for similar services; in case of the death or resignation of said treasurer at any time during the term for which he shall have been appointed or elected, the County Commissioners shall within twenty days thereafter appoint some one to fill said vacancy, who shall take the oath and give the bond hereinbefore required to be taken and given by the treasurer; and the treasurer shall, at the expiration of his term of office, transfer and deliver to his successors in office all books, accounts and papers of every kind connected with his office.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 43.

AN ACT to amend Chapter three hundred and thirty-four of the Acts of eighteen hundred and ninety, entitled "An Act to regulate the sale and granting of licenses for the sale of spirituous and fermented liquors in Baltimore County," by adding three new Sections to said Act, to follow immediately after Section 19, and to be known as Section 19 A, Section 19 B and Section 19 c.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That chapter three hundred and thirty-four of the Acts of eighteen hundred and ninety are hereby amended by adding three additional sections thereto, to follow after section 19 and to be known as section 19 A, section 19 B and section 19 c.

Section 19 A. The steward or officer of such club or corporation, at the time he files an application for a license in substantial compliance with the provisions of section 3 of this Act, regulating the application of an individual for a license, shall include in the sworn application for such license a list of the *bona fide* members of the club or corporation applying for a license, and no such license shall be granted unless such club or corporation shall own or regularly rent or lease a habitation or place of meeting in Baltimore county.

Section 19 B. If any such club, association or corporation or officer or agent thereof shall sell, give, barter or in any way furnish or dispense intoxicating liquor or any admixture thereof to any person, whether a member thereof or not,
