SEO. 10. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 481.

AN ACT to amend Section fifty-nine of Article ten of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," subtitle "Cambridge," as amended by the Acts of nineteen hundred, Chapter three hundred and thirty-nine, by adding a new sub-section thereto, to be numbered twenty-six, and to follow immediately after twenty-five.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of New section added. Maryland, That a new sub-section be and the same is hereby added to section fifty-nine of Article ten of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Dorchester County," sub-title "Cambridge," to be known as twenty-six, and to follow immediately after twenty-five, and to read as follows:
