the year nineteen hundred and one; the said inability of said county has been subject to large expenses in the erection of school houses, and the fact that the small population is scattered over a large extent of territory, creating a large number of school houses for the number of pupils required to be taught therein; therefore,

CHAP. 62.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby directed to issue his warrant upon the Treasurer of the State in favor of the Board of County School Commissioners of Garrett Appropriacounty for the sum of nineteen hundred and fifty-two dollars and fifty-six cents; said sum, in addition to the amount to which said county is entitled to receive, to be paid out of the public school funds of the State under existing laws

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That the Comptroller be and he is hereby authorized and directed to apportion Garrett county its proper proportion of the said school tax for the year nineteen hundred and two, known as the March instalment of said school tax. school tax, to be made by the Comptroller in pursuance of law, on the fifteenth day of March in each year, in the same manner as if the schools of Garrett county had been kept open seven and one-half months in the year ending December 31, nineteen hundred and two.

Apportion-

Sec. 3. And be it enacted, That the said Board of School Commissioners shall apply the said sums so received by the provisions of this Act to the support of the public schools of How applied. said county in the same manner as the other portions of the State school tax, received by said county, are intended to be applied under the provisions of the existing laws of this State.

Sec. 4. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 63

AN ACT to amend the Charter of the Mechanics' Loan and Savings Institute, at Hagerstown, Maryland, so as to authorize the said Institute to engage in and conduct a general banking business.

WHEREAS, Mechanics' Loan and Savings Institute, at Hagerstown, Maryland, was duly incorporated by chapter 93, Laws of Maryland, passed at the session of 1860, for the Preamble purpose of conducting a loan and savings institute; and
