CHAPTER 6.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the County Commissioners of Washington County to levy a sum of money to refund to Emma K. Martin, of said county, certain taxes erroneously paid by her.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Washington county be and they are hereby authorized and directed to levy for the use of Emma K. Martin, of said county, the sum of twelve dollars, the amount of county taxes paid erroneously by her for the year nineteen hundred and one.
