

to 116, inclusive, of Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Charles County," sub-title "La Plata," and Chapter 486 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session of eighteen hundred and ninety-four, entitled an Act to repeal Sections 91, 96 and 105 of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, entitled "Charles County," sub-title "La Plata," and to enact the following in lieu thereof, and to re-enact said Sections 91 to 116, inclusive, of Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Charles County," sub-title "La Plata," with amendments, and to re-enact the same with amendments, and to add certain new Sections to the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Charles County," sub-title "La Plata," to come in after Section 116, and to be numbered, respectively, as Sections 116 A, 116 B, 116 C, 116 D, 116 E, 116 F, 116 G, 116 H.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That sections 92 and 102 of chapter 518 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, nineteen hundred, being an Act entitled an Act to repeal sections 91 to 116, inclusive, of Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Charles County," sub-title "La Plata," and chapter 486 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session of eighteen hundred and ninety-four, entitled an Act to repeal sections 91, 96 and 105 of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Charles County," sub title "La Plata," and to enact the following in lieu thereof, and to re-enact said sections 91 to 116, inclusive, of Article 9 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Charles County," sub-title "La Plata," with amendments, be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:

92. The corporate limits of said town shall be as follows: Beginning at a stone fixed in the earth on the south side of the main road leading through said town of La Plata from Bryantown to Port Tobacco, which point of beginning is south seventy-eight and one-half ($78\frac{1}{2}$) degrees west eight hundred and ninety-eight (898) feet from the south meridian stone in the court-house yard, and running south five and one-half ($5\frac{1}{2}$) degrees east, continuing and extending with the dividing line between the lands of William T. Maurics and L. Allison Wilmer, fifteen hundred and thirty-eight (1538) feet to a set
