Douglas and Charles Douglas, dated January 3, 1906, and intended to be recorded among said land records.

CHAP. 538

Sanction and consent given.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 539.

AN ACT to erect a suitable monument in the City of Baltimore to commemorate the patriotism and heroic courage of the sons of Maryland who, on land and sea, fought for the preservation of the Federal Union in the Civil War, 1861-5.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the sum of twenty-five thousand dollars be and the same is hereby appropriated out of any money in the treasury of Maryland not otherwise appropriated for the erection of a suitable monument in the city of Baltimore to commemorate the valor and courage of those sons of Maryland who, on land and sea, fought for the preservation of the Federal Union, Civil War, 1861-5.

Appropriation made.

SEC. 2. That the said monument shall have suitable designs or statues or figures thereon commemorating the different branches of the service—that is, of the infantry, cavalry, artillery and the navy.

Monument to have suitable designs.

SEC. 3. That the Governor of Maryland is hereby authorized and directed to appoint a monument commission, composed of seven Union soldiers or sailors of honorable record,

Monument commission appointed.
