On the day appointed in the notice for the appearance and answer of the parties named in the adjuster's return such persons may appear, and whoever appears shall be heard, and upon and after such hearing the Mayor and Council shall make decision as to the person who shall contribute to the expense thereof and as to the proportion in which the several persons shall pay, and the Mayor and Council shall pass an order setting forth their Any person assessed to pay part of the expenses of said improvement may appeal from such decision of the Mayor and Council at any time within thirty days to the Circuit Court for Worcester county, but if no appeal is taken within thirty days the Mayor and Council shall arrange for doing the work and furnishing the material. May provide provide materials and contract for doing the work, or they may contract with the same person for the materials and work; they may call on two or three persons skilled in such work to make an offer of terms on which they will do the work, and they shall accept the bid or offer of the person who in their judgment will furnish the best material and work for the least money, or who will do the best work on the most moderate terms.
