Pay of adjusters.

case of infants the proceedings to enforce the same shall be by bill in equity; the judgment under scire facias or the decree in equity shall set forth the priority which the assessment made by the order of the Mayor and Council holds and possesses in the premises; under the decree the payment of the lien may be compelled by execution or by appointment of a trustee to sell. The adjusters shall be paid one dollar per day each while performing the duty herein imposed on them.

Every male person over twenty-one years of age must work one day in the year on the streets.

Section 215 D. The year for repairing the streets, lanes, alleys and thoroughfares of said town shall be reckoned from the first day of May, inclusive, in one year to the first day of May, exclusive, in the next year. Every male person above the age of twenty-one years who has resided in said town four months shall be bound to work on said streets, lanes, alleys and thoroughfares for one day in each and every year as the year is herein defined; and if any person who is liable to render such work fails to attend as directed by notice from the policeman or who appears and fails or refuses to work or render service as by the person or persons supervising the work he is required and entrusted shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction thereof before a justice of the peace for Worcester county or in the Circuit Court for said county such person shall be fined one dollar and shall be adjudged to pay the costs and stand committed until such fine and costs are paid, and he shall be bound to render proper service at or about the first of January in each year, beginning with the year 1907; the town clerk shall make out a list of all persons who, on the first day of the next May, will be liable to render service on the streets of the town, and he shall as soon thereafter as convenient deliver said list to the policeman; each person named in said list, who shall pay the policeman the sum of one dollar in lieu of performing said service upon the streets, shall receive a receipt from the policeman exempting from service for the year beginning on the first day of May as aforesaid. ning on said first day of May the policeman shall from time to time call out for service upon the streets all the persons on said list who shall not have paid the exemption fee above persons who named, and he shall allow no person to escape from said service; and it shall be the duty of the policeman whenever any person who is subject to render such service fails to
