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CHAPTER 559.

AN ACT to amend the charter and enlarge the powers of the Elkridge Building and Loan Association of Howard County, so as to enable it to loan money on promissory notes and bills obligatory.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Elkridge Building and Loan Association of Howard County be and the same is hereby authorized and empowered to lend money on promissory notes and bills obligatory; provided, however, that no loan of money on promissory notes or bills obligatory shall exceed the sum of two hundred dollars to any one person. Authority  
given to lend  
money.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

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CHAPTER 560.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Chapter 436 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session 1904, entitled "An Act to incorporate the town of Glen Echo, in Montgomery County, Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the citizens of the town of Glen Echo are hereby created a body corporate by the name and style of Mayor and Council of Glen Echo, with all the powers and privileges of a body politic and corporate, and by said corporate name may have perpetual succession, sue and be sued, plead and be impleaded in any court of law or equity and may have and use a common seal.
