person or persons or body corporate, to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer in Burkittsville district, outside of the corporate limits of Burkittsville, in Frederick Unlawful for county; excepting, however, from the operation of this Act, any persons or body corporate conducting a distillery situate in said Burkittsville district.

issue license

Section 311q. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That any person who may wish to sell spirituous or fermented liquors, or lager beer, within the corporate License tee of limits of said city of Burkittsville, in said Frederick county, shall, after complying with all the provisions of existing laws, pay to the clerk of the Circuit Court for said county, for a license authorizing such sale, the sum of one hundred dollars in addition to the price now fixed by Article 56 of the Code of Public General Laws, and Chapter 201 of the Acts of Assembly, passed at the session of 1892, and said license shall not be issued for a less period than one year.

Section 311R. Any person who may wish to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer, in the corporate limits of Burkittsville, in said county, shall, upon complying granting of with the provisions of existing laws, pay to the clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick county, for a license authorizing such sales, the sum of one hundred dollars, in addition to the sum which such persons would be required to pay under said Article 56 of the Acts of Assembly of Maryland, passed at the Session of 1892.

Section 311s. The clerk of the Circuit Court for Frederick county shall, from the monies so received for such license mentioned in the preceding sections, pay first to the State of Maryland the amount now received by it for such license Maryland the amount now received by it for such license money in said town of Burkittsville, and the excess over and above license. the sum now charged by the State for such license in said town shall be paid by said clerk unto the commissioners of Burkittsville, to be used by said corporate authorities of said town in their discretion, as they may deem proper.

Section 311 T. Any person who shall hereafter be convicted of selling intoxicating spirituous or fermented liquors or any other admixture thereof in the said town of Burkitts- for selling without a license under the provisions of this sub-title, liquor withshall be sentenced to pay a fine of not less than one hundred dollars nor more than five hundred dollars, or undergo
