

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Northern Central Railway Company be and it is hereby required to erect a station and to stop all local passenger trains thereat at the place where said Northern Central Railway crosses the Falls road in Baltimore county.

Station authorized to be erected, etc.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 569.

AN ACT to authorize, empower and direct the School Commissioners of Montgomery County, Maryland, to purchase or secure a site and erect thereon a school building in Glen Echo, of said County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the school commissioners of Montgomery county are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to purchase or otherwise secure a site and erect thereon a suitable school building in Glen Echo, of said county, the same to be equipped as a graded school.

Purchase a site and erect a school.

SEC. 2. That the school building provided for in this Act shall be completed not later than January 1, 1907.

When to be completed.

CHAPTER 570.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 59 of Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Garrett County," sub-title "Treasurer," as amended by Chapter 134 of the Acts of 1898.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 59 of Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Garrett County," sub-title "County Treasurer," as amended by Chapter 134 of the Acts of 1898, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows :

Repeal and re-enact.

59. The said treasurer shall receive as compensation for all the services required of him under this sub-title of this article one and one-half per cent. on all taxes actually collected
