

## CHAPTER 577.

CHAP. 577

AN ACT to amend the Charter of the Monocacy Valley Railroad, a corporation incorporated under the General Incorporation Laws of Maryland.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Monocacy Valley Railroad, a corporation duly incorporated under the general incorporation laws of Maryland, be and the same is hereby authorized and empowered to extend its lines from its present terminus at Catoctin Furnace, Maryland, to Frederick, Maryland.

Authority to extend its lines.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 578.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 180 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws of the State of Maryland, title "Allegany County," for the purpose of securing to the residents of said county the right of trial in the district in which they may reside, or in which the contract has been made, or the alleged violation of law has taken place.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That Section 180 of Article 1 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Allegany County," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows :

Repeal and re-enact.

180. It shall not be lawful for any resident of Allegany county to be sued before any justice of the peace of said county out of the election district in which he resides, unless the contract or cause of action originated in the district wherein suit is brought, and it shall not be lawful for any magistrate to issue a warrant against any resident of said county authorizing his arrest or to try any such offender after his arrest, unless the alleged offender shall reside in said election district or the offense or crime complained of shall have arisen in the election district for which such justice of the peace has been appointed ; provided, however,

When unlawful for any resident of Allegany county to be sued.
