To the grant and conveyance by the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to St. Peter's Evangelical Lutheran Church of Baltimore city of a lot of ground on the west side of Aiken street, south of North avenue, in the city of Baltimore, described in a deed thereof from said grantor, dated April 13, 1905, and duly of record among the land records of Baltimore city, in Liber R. O., No. 2138, folio 283, etc.
