16. For the creation and maintenance of mechanics' institutes, co-operative stores or societies, libraries, public reading rooms, medical societies, public hotels, public baths, dairy associations, poultry associations for the purpose of dealing in eggs, increase of poultry and other things connected with poultry farming and agriculture or horticulture societies, fairs, or exhibitions, and companies for the packing of fruits, vegetables and other things; provided, such corporations are located in this State and the property they possess or acquire is located therein.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 723.

AN ACT to exempt from taxation the real and personal property of the Vestry of the Church of the Holy Innocents, of the city of Baltimore, a body corporate, so long as said property is used for charitable or benevolent purposes.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, It is represented to the General Assembly of Maryland that the vestry of the Church of the Holy Innocents, a Protestant Episcopal Church of the city of Baltimore, a religious organization, has purchased a certain house on the northeast corner of Chase and Eden streets, in the city of Baltimore, to be used as a Guild House for charitable and religious purposes, in connection with said church, and not for profit or gain; therefore,

Exempt from  
taxes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That said property, real and personal, be and the same is hereby declared exempt from city and State taxation so long as it is used for said purposes.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
