Sec. 28. And be it enacted. That whoever, during the hours of any primary election or canvass of votes, or of making returns thereof in any election district shall bring, take, Unlawful to order or send into, or shall attempt to bring or take or send into any place of primary election, any distilled or spirituous liquors, wine, ale or beer, or shall at any such time and place, drink or partake of such liquor, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and shall, upon conviction thereof be fined not less than ten (\$10) dollars nor more than one hundred (\$100) dollars.

Sec. 29. And be it enacted. That it shall be unlawful for the keeper of any hotel, tavern, store or any other establishment, or for any person or persons, corporation or corpo-Unlawful to rations, directly or indirectly, to sell, barter, give or dispose of any spirituous or fermented liquors, ale or beer or intoxicating drinks of any kind on the day of any primary election hereafter to be held in Montgomery county. Any person or corporation violating the provisions of this Act shall be liable for indictment, and shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than fifty (\$50) dollars or more than one hundred (\$100) dollars for each offense; one-half of the fine shall be paid to the informer and the other half to the County Commissioners for the use of public roads.

sell or give away liquors etc., on day of election.

SEC. 29. And be it enacted, That any person who shall make any bet or wager upon the result of any primary Liable to election to take place in Montgomery county shall be liable indictment. to indictment, and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than fifty (\$50) dollars or more than five hundred (\$500) dollars, to be paid to the County Commissioners for the use of the public roads.

SEC. 30. And be it enacted, That whoever shall electioneer, conduct a voter (except when physical disability requires assistance), or attempt to influence the vote of any voter Unlawful to within one hundred feet of any polling place of primary election in Montgomery county, or who shall place a distinguishing mark upon any ballot or envelope delivered to for the use of any voter at any such primary election, or who shall provide for or enclose in any envelope to be used in voting such ballot, any enclosure thereby identify the ballot, or who shall endeavor to induce any voter within the polling place to show how his ballot has been marked, or who shall carry away or attempt

electioneer or attempt to influence the vote of voters, etc.
