CHAP. 744

AN ACT to repeal Sections 19 and 20 A of Chapter 136 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, 1892, entitled "An Act to Incorporate the Town of Aberdeen, in Harford County," as repealed and re-enacted by the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, 1904, Chapter 437, and to re-enact said Section 20 A with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 19 and 20 A of Chapter 136 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Repeal and Session, 1892, entitled "An Act to incorporate the town of Aberdeen, in Harford County," as repealed and re-enacted by the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session, 1904, Chapter 437, be and the same are hereby repealed, and said Section 20 A is hereby reenacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:

Section 20 A. The town commissioners of Aberdeen shall, before the 15th day of May, 1906, and every second year thereafter, before said date, appoint a treasurer from the town of Treasurer Aberdeen, who shall hold his office for two years from and after his appointment, and until his successor has been duly appointed and qualified, as hereinafter provided, and shall, before he enters upon the discharge of his duties as such treasurer, execute and deliver a good and sufficient bond to the said town of Aberdeen in the penalty of five thousand dollars, conditioned for the faithful performance of his duties as treasurer, said bond to be approved by the said town commissioners; and if at any time a vacancy shall occur in said office the said commissioners shall at once make a new appointment for the residue of the term.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
