SEC. 4. And be it further enacted. That the said Emmitsburg Railroad Company is hereby authorized and empowered to build, buy and operate along its line of railroad and its Authority to extensions or connections, telegraph and telephone lines for its own business and that of its customers, and to charge such reasonable compensation for the use of the same as shall be determined by its board of directors.

Sec. 5. And be it further enacted, That the annual meeting of stockholders for the election of directors of said railroad company shall be held on the first Wednesday of each year, Annual mootas provided by Section 6 of Chapter 195, Acts of 1868, and that the number of directors so elected shall be six, as provided by Section 2 of the certificate of incorporation of the said railroad company, and who shall elect from their number a president, a vice-president, general manager, secretary and treasurer; which several officers may appoint, subject to the approval of the board of directors, such other officers and agents as may be necessary for the proper conduct of the business of said company.

Sec. 6. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

## CHAPTER 750.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of Cecil County to refund to W. Arthur Mitchell twenty-nine dollars and sixty cents, money erroneously paid into the treasury of Cecil County as County Taxes in the years 1902, 1903, 1904 and 1905.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of Cecil county, Maryland, be and they are hereby authorized and directed to Money refund to W. Arthur Mitchell twenty-nine dollars and sixty cents, money erroneously paid into the county treasury as county taxes for the years 1902, 1903, 1904 and 1905.
