

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the name of "The Sudlersville Savings Bank" be and the same is hereby changed from "The Sudlersville Savings Bank" to "The Sudlersville Bank of Maryland," and by such name and style shall have perpetual succession, to sue and be sued, to plead and be impleaded in any court whatever, to make and use a common seal, and alter and renew the same at pleasure, and shall have all the powers and enjoy all the privileges granted to "The Sudlersville Savings Bank," by said Act of Assembly of Maryland, January Session, 1904, Chapter 196.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That the date for the election of directors for said body corporate, by the stockholders thereof, shall be held on the second Monday in January of each year, instead of the first Monday in January, as provided in the original charter.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 756.

AN ACT to repeal Section 53 of Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Montgomery County," sub-title "Birds and Game," and re-enact the same with amendments.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Section 53 of Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Montgomery County," sub-title "Birds and Game," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows :

Section 53. It shall not be lawful to kill in Montgomery county any robin, blue bird, thrush, martin, mocking bird, barn swallow, mason swallow, lark, oriole, red bird, cat bird, chipping or summer sparrow, wren, pewit, goldfinch, sapsucker, hanging bird, woodpecker, fly catcher and tanager ; but nothing contained in this section shall be so construed as to prevent the killing or capture of crows, hawks, owls or other kinds of birds of prey.
