CHAPTER 764.

AN ACT to empower the Boys' School of St. Paul's Parish to receive and hold property whose income shall not exceed the annual sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.)

Authority to take property by gift, etc. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Boys' School of St. Paul's Parish, incorporated under Chapter 95 of the Acts of 1856 of the General Assembly of Maryland, be and the same is hereby authorized to take property of all kinds by gift, legacy, devise or otherwise, by any name designated for or intended for the said corporation, and that no misnomer shall render the same invalid, provided such design or intent appears. That said corporation may take and hold property of all kinds in manner aforesaid, whose income shall not exceed the annual sum of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000.)

Perpetual

SEC. 2. That the existence of said corporation is hereby made perpetual; and this Act shall take effect from its passage, subject to the right of the State of Maryland to repeal, alter or amend the same at pleasure.

CHAPTER 765.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Section 39 of Article 16 of the Code of Public General Laws, title "Chancery."

Repeal and re-enact. SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 39 of Article 16 of the Code of General Laws of Maryland, title "Chancery," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:

39. When a bill prays for a divorce a vinculo matrimoni, the fact that the parties have been divorced a mensa et thoro shall not be taken to interfere with the jurisdiction of the court over the subject, and a party who has obtained a divorce a mensa et thoro on the ground of abandonment, which at the time of obtaining said divorce was not of the
