And be it further enacted, That all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with the provisions of this Act are hereby repealed, so far as the same effects Garrett county; provided, however, that nothing contained in this Act shall in any manner effect any case or cases now pending, or any violations of the law which have heretofore occurred, but that all such cases and violations shall be prosecuted to a

CHAPTER 794.

AN ACT to repeal Section 183 of Article 81, Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, 1904, title "Revenue and Taxes," sub-title "Tax on Mortgages," and re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 183 of Article 81, Code of Public General Laws of Maryland, 1904, title "Revenue and Taxes," subtitle "Tax on Mortgages," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:

183. All mortgages, or assignees holding mortgages of
