An Act to amend the charter of the Supreme Council of United Craftsmen, as amended by Chapter 512 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session of 1904, entitled "An Act to change the name, extend the privileges and amend the charter of the Supreme Council of United Craftsmen of Dorchester county, a corporation duly incorporated under the General Laws of this State," by repealing Sections 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of said Act, and re-enacting the same with amendments, and adding thereto eight additional sections to follow immediately after Section 8, to be designated respectively as Sections 8A, 8B, 8C, 8D, 8E, 8F, 8G and 8H.	216
