CHAP. 133
Unlawful for clerk to issuelicense.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall not be lawful for the clerk of the Circuit Court for Garrett county, Maryland, to issue license to any person or persons, association or body corporate to sell spirituous or fermented liquors or lager beer at any place in Garrett county, within three miles of Barnum station, on the Western Maryland Railroad.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 134.

AN ACT to prevent the killing or trapping the foxes in Queen Anne's County.

Unlawful to kill fox, etc. Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That it shall not be lawful to kill or injure any fox in Queen Anne's county, when pursued by dogs.

Unlawful to sell any fox or hide. SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That it shall not be lawful to expose for sale any fox, or hide thereof, at any season of the year, and it shall not be lawful to shoot or trap any fox between November the first and April the first in each year; provided, nothing in this Act, however, shall prevent anyone from killing any fox when found depredating on poultry or stock at any season of the year.

Guilty of misdemeanor. SEC. 3. And be it enacted, That any person or persons guilty of violating any of the provisions of this Act shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof before some justice of the peace of said county shall pay a fine of ten dollars, one-half of which shall go to the informer and the other half into the school fund of said county, and in default of the payment of said fine shall be confined in the county jail for a term of not less than five or more than twenty days.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
