

CHAP. 140

Warrant to be drawn.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That the Treasurer of the State shall, on the warrant of the Comptroller, disburse the said sum of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes herein specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons entitled to receive the same.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

 CHAPTER 141.

AN ACT to empower the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to allow discounts for the early payment of benefit assessments under Chapter 87 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland for the year 1904, commonly known as the Burnt District Commission Act.

Empowered to allow certain discounts.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore be and it is hereby empowered to allow such discounts as it may deem advisable, for the early payment of benefit assessments under Chapter 87 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland for the year 1904, commonly known as the Burnt District Commission Act.

SEC. 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

 CHAPTER 142.

AN ACT to authorize and direct the Board of Fire Commissioners of the City of Baltimore to place on the pension roll of the Baltimore City Fire Department, William C. McAfee, formerly Chief Engineer of the Fire Department.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, William C. McAfee was a member of the fire department of the city of Baltimore for nearly fifteen years of continuous and faithful service; and

WHEREAS, The said William C. McAfee has become permanently disabled by reason of injuries received while chief engineer of the Baltimore City Fire Department,
