

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the Board of Fire Commissioners of Baltimore city be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to place on the pension roll of the fire department of Baltimore city William C. McAfee, formerly chief engineer of that department. CHAP. 142  
Placed on pension roll.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That the annual pension to be paid to the said William C. McAfee shall be "\$1,500.00" per annum, payable in monthly instalments. Pension to be paid.

SEC. 3. *Be it enacted,* That the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore be and they are hereby authorized and directed to appropriate annually the amount necessary to pay the above pension. Appropriation to be made.

SEC. 4. *Be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect on May 1, 1906.

Approved March 22, 1906.

#### CHAPTER 143.

AN ACT to regulate the compensation of the County Commissioners of Allegany County, as to repeal all laws inconsistent herewith, as follows :

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Allegany county now in office, and those hereafter elected to said office, shall meet as often as they deem necessary, and they shall receive as full compensation for all their services the sum of five hundred dollars per annum. Time of meeting.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with this Act be and the same are hereby repealed. Repeal.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

#### CHAPTER 144.

AN ACT to amend Article 4, "City of Baltimore," of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, by repealing and re-enacting with amendments Sub-section "Sewers," of Section 6, title "General Powers."
