stituted, may, by an addition or amendment to its constitution, designate the location of the home office of this corporation. If no such designation or provision is made by the May designate supreme council in its constitution, the home office shall be new home. at Cambridge, Maryland, where it is now located; provided, in any event, the supreme council may hold its meetings in any State, and the board of supreme directors, for its convenience, may hold a part of its meetings elsewhere than at its home office.

That all of the officers of this corporporation, whose duty it is to handle any of the funds, shall, before entering upon the discharge of their duties, give bond for the faithful Bond to be performance of said duties in some solvent, reliable and reputable surety, fidelity or guarantee company, in such sum or sums as from time to time may be determined by the directors of this corporation.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 165.

AN ACT to repeal Section 3 of Chapter 314 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Session of 1894, and to re-enact the same with amendments, providing for local guard boats during the oyster season at the mouth of the Tred Avon river, in Talbot County, and Chester river, in Queen Anne's and Kent Counties.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 3 of Chapter 314 of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January Ses-Repeal and re-enact. sion of 1894, relating to guard boats during the oyster season at the mouth of the Tred Avon river, in Talbot county, and Chester river, in Queen Anne's and Kent counties, be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:

Section 3. Be it enacted, That the said Board of Public Works shall be authorized to rent or hire two suitable boats to assist in guarding the waters at the mouth of Tred Avon
