within such time as the commissioners may direct, qualify and bond, as directed in the preceding section; and the County Commissioners are hereby authorized to remove the treasurer for any misconduct or neglect by him committed in the discharge of the duties of his office.

Duties to be performed.

C. He shall perform all the duties now by law required to be performed by said clerk, or which may be required of him by any future law or by any order of the County Commissioners.

May appoint assistants.

D. He shall have the power, subject to the approval of the County Commissioners, to appoint such assistant or assistants, at a compensation not exceeding eighteen hundred dollars in the aggregate, as he may deem necessary and proper for the faithful and efficient performance of the work of his office, and the assistant or assistants so appointed shall take the oath of office prescribed by the Constitution of this State, and shall execute such bond or bonds as the said clerk may require.

To have charge of all records, etc.

E. He shall have charge of all records, books and so forth, belonging to the office of the County Commissioners, and shall not allow any of them to be removed or taken from said office, except in obedience to a summons or order of a court of law or equity of this State, and shall deliver the same to his successor.

Collect all taxes and receive all moneys due to county, etc.

F. He shall collect all taxes levied by the County Commissioners, and shall receive all moneys due to said county from any source whatever, and shall disburse the same under the provisions of law and the order of the County Commissioners. It shall be his duty to promptly deposit all monies and receipts by him collected in some bank, or banks, or banking institution or institutions of Montgomery county, to be approved by the County Commissioners, and it shall be obligatory upon said commissioners to prefer, in approving such place or places of deposit, the bank or institution, or banks or institutions, which shall agree to pay 2 per cent. upon monthly balance of such deposits over such as may not be willing to pay said interest.

Notice to be given in two newspapers.

G. He shall, as soon as the annual levy is made, give notice thereof by advertisement in two newspapers published in Montgomery county, which notice shall state the time from which taxes bear interest and shall warn all taxpayers of their liability, to be published as delinquent taxpayers
