## CHAPTER 29.

AN ACT to amend and extend the Charter of The Mutual Fire Insurance Company of Carroll County, a body corporate of the State of Maryland.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland. That the charter of The Mutual Fire Insurance Company Perpetual of Carroll County, a corporation created under the general laws of the State of Maryland relating to corporations, be and the same is hereby so amended that the duration of said corporation shall be perpetual.
