Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sum of fifteen hundred dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby ap-sum of money propriated for the use of the said Public Records Commission of Maryland, to be paid by the Treasurer of the State of Maryland out of any moneys in the State treasury not otherwise appropriated, upon the warrant of the Comptroller.

Sec. 2. And be it enacted. That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 212.

AN ACT to provide for an additional Justice of the Peace for the Third Election District of Montgomery County.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the Governor be and is hereby authorized and Justice of the empowered to appoint an additional justice of the peace in and for the Third Election District of Montgomery county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 213.

AN ACT to authorize the County Commissioners of St. Mary's County to levy a sum of money not exceeding five hundred dollars, to build a school house for white children at or near Stacia Springs, in the Third Election District of St. Mary's County.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the County Commissioners of St. Mary's county, be and they are hereby authorized to levy a sum of money Levy to be not exceeding five hundred dollars, for the building of a school house for white children at or near Stacia Springs, in the Third Election District of St. Mary's county.

SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That the Board of County Contract to be School Commissioners of said county shall, in their discretion, contract for the building of said school house by bids school house.
