SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 214.

AN ACT to authorize and empower the County Commissioners of Somerset County to build a bridge over "King's Creek" in said county and to levy upon the assessable property of said county a sum of money for the purpose of building said bridge.

Bridge to be  
built over  
King's creek.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That the County Commissioners of Somerset county be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, if in their discretion they shall deem it necessary for the convenience of the public, to build a bridge over "King's Creek" in said county, of such a width as in their discretion may be necessary, and of such height and structure as may be sufficient to allow the passage thereunder or through of such boats as have been accustomed to navigate the said "King's Creek" at the place of said bridge ; the said bridge to be located at such place as the said County Commissioners may deem best in their discretion for the convenience of the public to be benefited thereby.

Levy to be  
made.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That for the purpose of building said bridge the said County Commissioners are hereby authorized to levy a sum of money upon the assessable property of said county not exceeding \$1,200.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
