

CHAP. 221

New section
added.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That an additional section be and the same is hereby added to Article 16 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Montgomery County," sub-title "Rockville," to follow immediately after Section 212 of said Article, to be designated as Section 212 A, and to read as follows :

Flagman to be
employed.

212 A. The Baltimore and Ohio Railroad Company is hereby required to keep, in addition to the safty gates operated from the present or any other tower, a flagman or signalman stationed during each and every day from 6 o'clock A. M. to 9 o'clock P. M. at the crossing of its railroad over Baltimore Street in said town to warn persons using said street and crossing over said railroad at said crossing of the approach of trains upon said railroad.

SEC. 2. *Be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 222.

AN ACT to add a new section to Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County" sub-title "Hagerstown," to be numbered Section 179 A, and to follow Section 179.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That a new section be and the same is hereby added to Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Hagerstown," to be numbered Section 179 A, and to follow Section 179, and to read as follows :

Officers ap-
pointed.

179 A. The Mayor and Council shall provide two officers centrally located, one for each of two justices of the peace for districts three, seventeen, twenty-one, twenty-two, twenty-four and twenty-five, constituting Hagerstown and vicinity; provided, however, that the two justices of the peace may have their offices together should they so desire.
