Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That the sanction and consent of said General Assembly Sanction and of Maryland be and the same is hereby declared, given and granted to the bequest and devise by Edward Hagthorp, Sr., to the pastor of St. Patrick's Church, contained in the last will and testament of said Edward Hagthorp, Sr., dated December 31, 1842, and duly probated by the Orphans' Court of Baltimore City, and recorded in the office of the Register of Wills, D. M. P. No. 19, folio 224.

AN ACT to provide for an additional Notary Public in the Sixth Election District of Harford County.
