SEC. 2. And be it enacted, That all Acts or parts of Acts conflicting with this Act, and any Act giving any aid or appropriation in addition to this Act to the Maryland State Repeal. Fireman's Association, be and the same is hereby repealed.

CHAP. 47

SEC. 3. And be it further enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 47.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 306, 308 and 314 of Article 27 of the Code of Public General Laws of 1904, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Mineral Waters, Porter and other Beverages," so as to make the provisions of Sections 306 to 315, both inclusive, apply to dealers in milk and cream and their by-products.

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Sections 306, 308 and 314 of Article 27 of the Repeal and Code of Public General Laws, title "Crimes and Punishments," sub-title "Mineral Waters, Porter and other Beverages," be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:

306. Any and all persons, partnerships or bodies corporate; engaged in manufacturing, bottling, selling or dealing in mineral, soda or æriated waters, wines, beer, lager beer, weiss beer, white beer or other beverages, or milk, cream or their by-products, including ice cream in kegs, boxes, trays, carriers, crates, founts, bottles, syphons, jugs, tins, barrels, casks or any other vessels, with his, her, its, or their name or names or other marks or devices printed, branded, stamped, stencilled, engraved, etched, blown, impressed or otherwise produced upon such kegs, boxes, trays, carriers, crates, founts, bottles, syphons, jugs, tins, barrels, casks or any other vessel, may file with the clerk of the Circuit Court of the county in which his, her, its or their principal office or place of business (or in the case of a foreign corporation, its principal office or place of business or agency) is located, or with the clerk of the Superior Court of Baltimore City, should such principal office or place of business (or

the names, marks or devices used to be filed with the clerk, etc.
