SEC. 3. And be it further enacted. That the County Commissioners for Anne Arundel county be and they are hereby authorized and directed to levy on the assessable property Tax to be levied. of said county, in such manner and at the next annual levy thereof, such sums of money as may be necessary to carry out and secure the provisions of this Act; provided, however, that such levy shall so be made as to complete said bridge and roads suitable for public travel leading thereto during the year nineteen hundred and six, provided that the cost of said bridge and constructing necessary roads to reach the same and putting them in proper and legal condition for travel, shall not exceed the sum of three thousand five hundred dollars.

SEC. 4. And be it enacted, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 55.

AN ACT to repeal Section 166 of Article 22 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Hagerstown," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Section 1. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That Section 166 of Article 22 of the Code of Public Repeal and Local Laws, title "Washington County," sub-title "Hagerstown," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted, so as to read as follows:

Section 166. The tax collector shall collect all taxes assessed and levied by the Mayor and Council for general and special purposes as authorized by this sub-title of this Duties of tax Article; he shall keep an account of all moneys collected and received by him and shall credit the same on his books to the particular head or item of expenses for which the same have been levied, collected or received; he shall receive all moneys which may be collected by the clerk under any ordinance passed in pursuance of the power conferred by Section 171 of this sub-title of this Article, and all moneys which shall be paid over to him by the clerk and collector as aforesaid under any ordinances passed under the power conferred by Section 171 of this sub-title of this Article; he
