CHAP. 56

WHEREAS, The thoroughfare in the thirteenth election district of Baltimore county leading easterly from the Washington road near Sulphur Spring road to Hammond's Ferry road at Lansdowne, has existed and been used by the general public without interruption for more than fifty years, and is a public convenience and necessity; but being less than thirty feet wide the local laws for Baltimore county prohibit the acceptance thereof by the Highways Commission of Baltimore county as a county road without a special Act authorizing the same; therefore,

Preamble.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the thoroughfare in the thirteenth election district of Baltimore county leading easterly from the Washington road near Sulphur Spring road to Hammond's Ferry road at Lansdowne, be and the same is hereby made and declared to be a public highway and county road, and as such shall hereafter be maintained by the Highway's Commission of Baltimore county and their successors, who are hereby authorized to ascertain and define the present width of said road, and to widen the same to thirty feet or more in their discretion, by purchase or condemnation of the abutting property.

Declared a public highway.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That all Acts or parts of Acts inconsistent with this Act, be and the same are hereby repealed in so far as they are in conflict with this Act.

Repeal.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.
