

can read the same; and in case said purchaser cannot read, the seller shall read said label to him, and such label shall be a guarantee of the material used in the manufacture of the article sold, and shall remain on said mattress when sold and delivered. Any person offending against the provisions of this sub-title of this Article of the Code shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and on conviction before a justice of the peace shall be fined for each offense not less than twenty-five nor more than fifty dollars, and in default of payment be committed to a jail for not less than ten nor more than thirty days, unless sooner discharged by payment or by due process of law. No manufacturer or seller of said articles shall be required to state on said label the quantity of the different materials used, but only the character and quality.

CHAP. 358

Guilty of misdemeanor.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 359.

AN ACT to repeal and re-enact with amendments Sections 168 and 195 H of Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Garrett County," sub-title "Oakland," as said sections were enacted and amended by Chapter 343 of the Acts of 1892 and by Chapter 123 of the Acts of 1896 and by Chapter 25 of the Acts of 1898.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That Sections 168 and 195 H of Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws, title "Garrett County," sub-title "Oakland," as said sections were enacted and amended by Chapter 343 of the Acts of 1892 and by Chapter 123 of the Acts of 1896 and by Chapter 25 of the Acts of 1898 be and the same are hereby repealed and re-enacted with amendments, so as to read as follows:

Repeal and re-enact.

Section 168. *And be it further enacted*, That the officers of said corporation shall be a mayor, a town council, which shall be composed of six members, a president of the town council, a town clerk, a treasurer, a tax collector, a police magistrate, an attorney, a weighmaster, a street commission
