

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the County Commissioners of Dorchester county be and they are hereby authorized and directed to build a bridge over Cabin creek, in said county, either at Coubourn's Landing or at Cat Landing, with a suitable draw for the passage of boats navigating the waters of said creek in said county, if necessary.

CHAP. 461

Build a bridge

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted,* That said County Commissioners are hereby authorized, empowered and directed to advertise at least four times in two newspapers of said county for sealed proposals to build or construct said bridge, and shall award the contract to the lowest responsible bidder, who shall be required to give bond and security to be approved by said County Commissioners, and said County Commissioners are hereby fully authorized and directed to open and build the necessary roads leading from said bridge.

SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That the said board of County Commissioners be and they are hereby authorized and empowered, in their discretion, to issue bonds for such sums as may be necessary to construct said bridge, the rate of interest on said bonds not to exceed four per cent. per annum; and the coupons for interest on said bonds shall be receivable by the collector for taxes for said county in payment of county taxes, and said bonds shall be exempt from county taxation, and to be due and payable at such time and in such sums as said County Commissioners may designate.

SEC. 4. *And be it enacted,* That this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 462.

AN ACT to regulate the salary of the clerk of the County Treasurer of Talbot County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted,* That accounting from the first day of January in the year 1906, the board of County Commissioners of Talbot county shall pay to the clerk to the county treasurer of said county an annual salary of one thousand dollars.
