taking of oysters in the Potomac river shall be concurrent as to the States of Maryland and Virginia, it is further provided that this Act shall take effect from the date of its passage; provided, concurrent legislation has heretofore been passed by the General Assembly of Virginia, or if not passed then, immediately upon the passage thereof.

SEC. 2. *And be it enacted*, That upon the taking effect in the State of Virginia of the provisions prescribed in the preceding section, the Governor of Maryland shall issue his proclamation declaring the provisions of this Act to be effective.
