

## CHAPTER 79.

AN ACT to repeal Section one hundred and sixty-six of Article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Frederick," as re-enacted by Section one of Chapter eight of the Acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January session of eighteen hundred and ninety-two, relating to the publication of the list of qualified voters of Frederick City.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That section one hundred and sixty-six of article eleven of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, title "Frederick County," sub-title "Frederick," as re-enacted by section one of chapter eight of the acts of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at January session, eighteen hundred and ninety-two, be and the same is hereby repealed, and no publication of the entire lists of qualified voters of Frederick city shall hereafter be required. Repeal.

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That chapter 61 of the Laws of Maryland, 1890, title "An act to enable the Mayor and City Council of Baltimore to appropriate a sum of money annually for the relief of the Saint Joseph's House of Industry of Baltimore," be and the same is hereby repealed and re-enacted so as to read as follows, viz: Repeal.
