

used for agricultural purposes, which assessment shall not exceed the assessment of the same for State and county taxes; and the commissioners may levy a tax thereon not exceeding in any one year ten cents on each one hundred dollars' worth of assessable property.

Tax lists.

SEC. 14. *And be it enacted*, That whenever the commissioners shall levy a tax, they shall cause to make out an alphabetical list of the persons charged therein, and shall cause to be affixed thereto the respective sums to be collected from such persons and a warrant to the bailiff to collect the same, and the said bailiff shall have the power of distraint as collector of county taxes.

Duty of bailiff.

SEC. 15. *And be it enacted*, That the bailiff shall make all collections required of him, and pay the same to the clerk, within six months from the time the tax bill is placed in his hands.

Expenditures not to exceed receipts.

SEC. 16. *And be it enacted*, That the commissioners shall not expend or contract to expend, in any one year, more money than the amount receivable from taxes and other sources for that year.

Jurisdiction of officers.

SEC. 17. *And be it enacted*, That the County Commissioners, justices of the peace, sheriff, constables, and all State and county officers shall have, hold and exercise their offices and jurisdiction in said town as if this charter had not been granted.

Effective.

SEC. 18. *And be it enacted*, That this act shall take effect from the date of its passage.

CHAPTER 653.

AN ACT to repeal Section 28 of Article 12 of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, and entitled "Garrett County," sub title "Circuit Court," and to re-enact the same with amendments.

Repeal.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland*, That section twenty-eight of article twelve of the Code of Public Local Laws of Maryland, be and the same is hereby repealed and re enacted so as to read as follows:
