

Duty of treasurer. or sums of money herein appropriated for the objects and purposes herein specified, to or upon the order of the person or persons, or body politic or corporate, entitled to receive the same.

Effective. SEC. 3. *And be it enacted,* That this act shall take effect from and after the first day of October, eighteen hundred and ninety-four.

CHAPTER 655.

AN ACT to appropriate certain sums of money to the support of sundry schools and charitable institutions in the State of Maryland, for each of the two fiscal years ending on the thirtieth day of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-five, and the thirtieth day of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-six, respectively.

Appropriation to schools and charitable institutions. SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland,* That the sums of money hereinafter named, be and they are hereby appropriated to the support of the hereinafter mentioned schools and charitable institutions in the State, for each of the two fiscal years ending on the thirtieth day of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-five, and the thirtieth day of September, eighteen hundred and ninety-six, respectively, to wit:

1. To F. Knapp's English and German Institute for the training and education of indigent mutes, the sum of twelve hundred dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-five, and the like sum of twelve hundred dollars for the fiscal year eighteen hundred and ninety-six; and in consideration of said appropriation the said F. Knapp's English and German Institute is hereby required and directed to maintain twelve free scholarships heretofore established in said institute, for the training and education of indigent mutes, and to train and educate twelve indigent mutes, and to furnish them with necessary text books, appliances, and so forth.

2. To the Woman's Medical College of Baltimore, for the Hospital of Good Samaritans, the sum of fifteen hundred dol-
