An act to provide for the collection of the tax imposed upon packers, shippers and wholesale and retail dealers in oysters, by section 20 H of article 72 of the Code of Public General Laws, as enacted by chapter 278 of the Code of the General Assembly of Maryland, passed at the January session, 1892, and the payment of the salaries of the several oyster inspectors appointed under the provisions of section 20 G of the same act . . . . .	896
No. 582. An act to permit fishing with pound nets in the waters of the Chesapeake Bay, from a point two hundred yards westward from the extreme north end of Howels Point to the north end of the broad beach at the mouth of Still Pond Creek . . . . .	897
No. 583. An act to authorize the "President and Commissioners" of North East, in Cecil county, to issue bonds to an amount not exceeding five thousand dollars for the purpose of improving the streets, highways and sidewalks of the town . .	899
