Kuszmane and Son, John R. Barnickel, Isaac B. Clark, John Heinzerling and Samuel J. Leonard, trading as Heinzerling and Leonard, George C. Sucro, agent of the Bartholomay Brewing Company, and Henry L. Lemkuhl, the amounts of money respectively paid by them to the clerk of the Court of Common Pleas of Baltimore city, for licenses for the years eighteen hundred and ninety and eighteen hundred and ninety-one, in excess of the amounts with which they were properly chargeable, and which respective amounts have been by said clerk paid to the State.....	906
